As we approach our 29th Crested Butte Open, I want to extend a warm invitation to join us in supporting the heart of our mission: empowering people with disabilities though exceptional outdoor experiences. Your sponsorship at the CB Open is not just a financial contribution; it is a crucial investment in transforming lives and creating a lasting impact.

At the Adaptive Sports Center, we are committed to breaking barriers and redefining what is possible for individuals living with any sort of different abilities. This commitment has led to an evergrowing demand for our services. Our unique approach involves providing inclusive outdoor adventures that go beyond physical challenges, aiming to instill a sense of empowerment, resilience, and joy. The CB Open is a cornerstone event that allows us to raise the funds necessary to continue offering these lifechanging experiences to our participants.

Your sponsorship is vital for several reasons. First, it directly enables us to subsidize the cost of every lesson. Our current Access for All pricing delivers a lesson with a professional instructor, all equipment necessary, and a lift ticket for just \$95 a day. Our true cost for this day is about ten times that. People with disabilities often experience much greater costs of living and far fewer opportunities

for employment. The combination of which makes our affordable pricing extremely important and allows more people to participate. Your support ensures that financial barriers do not hinder access to these transformative experiences. Secondly, your sponsorship helps Adaptive bring in more than 40 visiting groups from around the nation. We support these groups by covering some or all of their transportation costs, running airport shuttles, providing accommodations in one of our accessible lodges, stocking their kitchens with healthy food for the week, preparing lunches onsite to fuel them between morning and afternoon lessons, and sometimes covering a dinner or two out in Crested Butte. For example, last year we provided 103 shuttles, 1,505 nights of lodging, and prepared and served 4,486 meals!

Thank you for being a part of our Adaptive family and for considering this opportunity to make a meaningful impact on our participants. Together, we can create a world where outdoor adventures are truly exceptional for everyone.


