The Adaptive Mountain Biking World Championship seeks to create a competitive environment for all adaptive mountain bikers across a wide variety of riding styles and equipment.

Hosted at Crested Butte Mountain Resort and Lower Loop in town, the race weekend highlights some of the area's accessible riding with trails that will challenge even the most experienced riders. Each stage tests a different set of skills, from climbing prowess to cross country loops to technical descending and climbing. Two days of racing provides riders with the opportunity to meet new people and grow their community with riders from across the country.

\$95 FULL DAY LESSONS

Advocating for equal access to outdoor recreation activities for people with disabilities is core to our mission. Since our inception in 1987, we have accomplished this by offering adaptive adventures at a reduced cost.

We recognize that the cost to enjoy the great outdoors is commonly a barrier to participation, considering the added requirement of specialized equipment and professional instruction.

The Access for All Initiative reduces the ASC's existing subsidized full-day rate to only \$95. A typical adaptive full-day lesson costs the ASC \$900 and sponsorships, donations and grants make up the remainder of the cost.
