\$95 FULL DAY LESSONS

Advocating for equal access to outdoor recreation activities for people with disabilities is core to our mission. Since our inception in 1987, we have accomplished this by offering adaptive adventures at a reduced cost.

We recognize that the cost to enjoy the great outdoors is commonly a barrier to participation, considering the added requirement of specialized equipment and professional instruction.

The Access for All Initiative reduces the ASC's existing subsidized full-day rate to only \$95. A typical adaptive full-day lesson costs the ASC \$900 and sponsorships, donations and grants make up the remainder of the cost.
